The goal of Promise is to help your child and family increase your income and improve your financial stability now and in the future.



<u>ELIGIBILITY</u>

Who is Promise for?



Youth between the ages of 14 and 16 who receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) are eligible to participate. Everyone in your household is likely to benefit.

Why should I enroll now?

- Enrollment is limited and ends April 30, 2016.
- Families who participate will receive \$30 in gift cards and have a 50% chance to receive a computer tablet and additional services.
